Have questions about your new little one? You're not alone. Here are some of the most common questions asked by parents.

Q Is there pediatric Urgent Care?

A Tanner Clinic has pediatric after hours Urgent Care at the Layton location until 8 p.m.

Q How important are routine health exams to my baby's health?

A Routine health exams are crucial. The recommended schedule is in the table to the right.

Q Is there always a pediatrician on duty at Tanner Clinic?

A A Tanner Clinic pediatrician is on call 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Urgent Care

Together, Eberhard and Hansen have clinic hours Monday through Friday from 9-5. Urgent care needs can be covered during those hours. In addition, there is a pediatric provider Monday thru Friday from 5 p.m. to 8 p.m. and on Saturday from 9 until noon. All services are provided at the Layton Tanner Clinic Pediatric department. In addition there is a family practice physician Urgent Care from 5-9 p.m. weekdays and 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. Saturdays.

Urgent Phone Calls

Eberhard and Hansen will handle urgent phone calls during the day. The urgent care staff will handle the call during urgent care hours (5-9 p.m.) When the clinic is closed, the on-call pediatrician can be reached by calling the answering service at (801) 621-3170. Please use this service courteously with only urgent concerns that can't wait until the next business day.

Routine Health Exams

Routine health exams are important to assure good growth, proper preventive care, immunizations, and development. During

the newborn period it is recommended to be seen "2,2,2." Two days after discharge, two weeks of age, then two months of age. Then four, six, nine, 12, 15, 18 and 24 months of age. The six and 18 months check ups need to be scheduled at least six months after the first Hep B and Hep A respectively. The AAP recommendation is to then do annual check ups near the child's birth.
