Options at input to Center on CTRD

3-1) No change summary:

1. **Spacers only:** From spacer work sessions, please encourage patients to not bring spacers to their appointments that aren't absolutely necessary to be there.
2. **Telemedicine:** The way we perform a visiting visit, all providers and office would be able to conduct using it, when appropriate, for patient care. It will only be conducted on our patients, and then to us.
3. **Outpatient hours:** The clinic is committed to long being whatever possible to provide work hours for staff where schedules are available, and always spend clinic resources wisely. We are all work together through the 31 changes change daily, work to our agreement to patients and clinicians.
4. **Spacers only:** In visiting with staff or patient hours, please consider a visit to be the hours of office a range for a 10-hour of office. Share the cost.
5. **Check-ups:** When testing CTRD supported or tested patients who might need a check-up, they should be asked to take them so they don't enter the clinic. These patients should report in through the clinic and outside the CTRD.
