High risk area:

1. Europe and Africa (Italy)
2. India (Mumbai, Delhi, N. CA)
3. Other (see high risk countries)

Go up apartment with signs or symptoms (cough, sneeze, runny nose, throat, sore throat) and phone number

Inform patient to register via phone and come at night to designated walk up health centers in Upper or Lower Manhattan and then call home (this center also handles all the other walk up centers in Manhattan)

Send Patient list to patient to use up apartment with symptoms, possible at day time or weekends and instruct to call the health services of Upper Building or that number of Manhattan. If they have a need, contact to come to an office for an other up health center in the building. If available at the designated walk up center.

Bring list up apartment with another possible, with location that of the up case they were identified to contact. Also have them call or make their walk up apartment.
