



What is a Cervical Incompetence?

The cervix normally gradually weakens from the pregnancy hormones that stimulate it to dilate and allow the fetus to pass. It can sometimes be the case it weakens a little earlier than normal and causes a Cervical Incompetence. What are the symptoms of CIC?

The symptoms of pregnancy loss that occur and you do not have a history of miscarriages or stillbirths include: bleeding like you are getting ready for the arrival of a baby, or a 'watery' discharge. The TIC will sign [a certificate](#) if your doctor is available.

What are the chances of a second pregnancy loss?
