



What is a Cervical Incompetence?

The cervix normally gradually weakens from the pregnancy hormones that stimulate it to dilate and allow the fetus to pass. It can sometimes be the cause of a miscarriage or a premature birth, especially if there is a history of Cervical Incompetence.
