has not been in humans before. Early studies suggest that it likely originated from a bat virus that mixed with a human virus. What are the symptoms of COVID-19? The most common symptoms are a fever that comes and goes, then cough, tiredness, and shortness of breath. Symptoms like runny nose and sore throat are less common in COVID-19. The CDC will update the symptoms as more studies are available.
