- 3. Add the exposure information to the fields
 - a. If the patient declines to answer, the check box can be clicked and all the other fields will be inactive
 - b. The URL will open up to the CDC website for more information
 - c. Clicking the "Detailed document" will enter the information in the Master Document
- 4. Click Add
 - a. All the information will now be in the Contagion Exposure History Grid
 - b. The star indicates an active exposure
- 5. Click OK

Deactivating a Patient's Contagion Exposure Risk

- 1. Select the Risk to be deactivated out of the Contagion Exposure History grid
- 2. Click on Deactivate check box
 - a. The date will default to today's date, but this can be changed.
- 3. Click Update
 - a. A pop up will warn you that this cannot be updated after it has been deactivated
- 4. Click Yes
 - a. The risk now will display in the Contagion Exposure Log
 - b. The Star will be removed showing the risk is now deactivated

Travel History Panel
