

All returning missionaries should be considered HIGH RISK.

This means:

Parents and guardians should pick missionaries up alone and practice safe social distancing while at the airport.

Missionaries should be immediately quarantined for 14 days.

This means:

NO public group, or family gatherings.

Separate living quarters if possible.

Keep six feet away from other household members.

Monitor for symptoms of fever, cough, or shortness of breath.

Family members living in the same house as the returned missionaries are considered MEDIUM RISK.

This means:

Maintain strict social distancing.

Be very aware of contact with vulnerable persons. This means no grandparents for 14 days.
