

All returning missionaries should be considered HIGH RISK.

This means:

Parents and guardians should pick missionaries up alone and practice safe social distancing while at the airport.

Missionaries should be immediately quarantined for 14 days.

This means:

- NO public, group, or family gatherings.
- Separate living quarters if possible.
- Keep six feet away from other household members.
- Monitor for symptoms of fever, cough, or shortness of breath.

Family members living in the same house as the returned missionaries are considered MEDIUM RISK.

This means:

- Maintain strict social distancing.
- Be very aware of contact with vulnerable persons. This means no grandparents for 14 days.
