

COVID-19 Screening Questions

1. Is the patient experiencing any fever?



2. Are there any respiratory symptoms (cough, shortness of breath)?

3. Has the patient traveled in the last 14 days?

International travel or been on a cruise ship
Stayed in the US with high density?



Has the patient been in close contact (within 6 feet) with someone who is suspected or has tested positive for COVID-19 including health care workers for COVID-19?

4.

Is the symptomatic individual an adult (age > 18 years) and/or with medical conditions such as immunocompromised state that increase an higher risk for poor outcomes - for e.g., diabetes, heart disease, renal insufficiency, immunosuppressive medications, lung disease, chronic kidney disease (nephrotic syndrome)?

REQUIRES CLINICAL JUDGMENT



Special populations:

- HCP regardless of exposure or asymptomatic
- Border/traveler to congested border town, long term care facilities, jail, group home, etc.
- Frequent health care contact (diabetes, chronic, including mental health symptoms)

The COVID-19 Case: The patient has a severe rapidly progressive respiratory illness of unknown etiology. Were tested to COVID-19.
