

COVID-19 Screening Questions

1. Is the patient experiencing any fever?



2. Are there any respiratory symptoms (cough, shortness of breath)?

3. Has the patient traveled in the last 14 days?

International travel or been on a cruise ship
- Does the patient have any high density?



Has the patient been in close contact (within 6 feet) with someone who is suspected or has tested positive for COVID-19 including health care workers for COVID-19?

4.

Is the symptomatic individual an adult (age > 18 years) and/or with medical conditions such as immunocompromised state that increase an higher risk for poor outcomes - for example, diabetes, heart disease, renal insufficiency, immunosuppressive medications, lung disease, chronic kidney disease, pregnancy?

REQUIRES CLINICAL JUDGMENT



Special populations:

- HCP regardless of exposure or asymptomatic
- Residents/workers in long-term care facilities, group homes, and other congregate settings
- Frequent health care contact (patients, family, including their frequent caregivers)

The COVID-19 Case: The patient has a severe rapidly progressive respiratory illness of unknown etiology. Were tested to COVID-19.
