

COVID-19 Screening Questions

1) patient experiencing
any fever

OR

respiratory symptoms:
cough, shortness of
breath?

2)

Has patient traveled in the last 14
days?

- International Travel or been on a
cruise ship
- States in the US with high
density?

OR

Has patient been in close contact
(within 6 feet) with someone who
is suspected of or has tested
positive for Covid-19 including
health care worker for Covid-19?

3)

Is the symptomatic individual an older
adult (age ≥ 60 years) and/or with
other medical conditions and/or an
immunocompromised state that makes
them at higher risk for poor outcomes?
- (e.g., diabetes, heart disease, recent
immunosuppressive medications, chronic
lung disease, chronic kidney disease,
pregnancy)

REQUIRES CLINICAL JUDGEMENT

OR

Special populations:

- HCW (regardless of exposure or
use)/First Responders
- Resident/worker in congregate
living (senior living, long term care facility,
shelter, jail, group home, **not** school)
- Frequent health care contact
(dialysis, chemo, including their
frequent caregivers)

For ED/Acute Care: The patient has a severe rapidly progressive
respiratory illness of unknown etiology. Warm Handoff to ED required.
