months of age who have been previously exposed to both hMPV and PIV3. This study is comprised of a total of eight in-office visits, and 12 phone calls, over a period of 14 months. Participation will include two vaccinations, five blood draws, collection of vital signs, a medical history evaluation, and physical exams. You will be compensated for your time and travel. The results of this study may help researchers learn whether the investigational vaccine is safe, tolerable and effective in toddlers.

Your child may qualify for this study if he or she is between 12 and 36 months old when beginning the study and:

- Has received routine immunizations appropriate for their age per the Centers for Disease Control and
 Proceeding (CDC) Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP)
- Prevention (CDC) Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP).

There are additional criteria your child must meet in order to participate, and the study doctor can discuss this with you and answer any questions you may have.

Study related care and the study vaccine will be provided at no cost.

Current height and weight above the third percentile for age.

 Eligible children are reimbursed for time and/or travel for completed study clinic visits up to \$1,250.
