

The content of your app, or **content**, may be a page with text or a Web page with a form to go and do something else. In this case, you use the `Text` widget and `TextForm` widget, respectively. Let's start by setting up the `Text` widget. In the `Text` widget, you can set the `text` property to any string you want. For example, you can set the `text` property to `"Hello World"`. The `Text` widget will display the text you set. The `Text` widget also has a `fontWeight` property that you can use to set the font weight of the text. For example, you can set the `fontWeight` property to `FontWeight.bold` to make the text bold.

## Form

1. Set the `text` property to `"Enter your name"`.
2. Set the `fontWeight` property to `FontWeight.bold`.
3. Set the `text` property to `"Enter your name"` and the `fontWeight` property to `FontWeight.bold`. It is possible to set the `text` property to a string that contains a newline character, such as `"Enter your name\n"`, to display the text on multiple lines.



4. **Make the form submit:** In the `onPressed` property of the `Text` widget, set the `onPressed` property to `onPressed`.
