

Rocky Mountain Allergy at Tanner Clinic

As an effect of the new guidelines, we will follow the course of the approved (2020) CL, we are including the following to our encouragement in your allergy shot classes:

Precautions:

1. **Initial injection:** Come to our program more than 24 hours before starting your injection (1 week)
2. **Subsequent visits:**
 1. If a fever is not recorded in the last 2 weeks, then do not come in for another 2 weeks
 2. If a fever is not recorded in 2-4 weeks, then come in and get a fever test that is not associated for another 2 weeks.

These guidelines were developed to help reduce the risk of COVID-19 in our patients.

Shot clinic hours are now **T-11am and 11-12pm Monday through Friday** and other times to allow discontinuity.

These changes are all approved by our local regulatory authorities. If you are not well from cough, sore throat, flu-like symptoms, or any other symptoms described by the CL, please do not come into clinic. If you have decided to come to visit or have already begun, please do not come into clinic.

We appreciate everyone understanding and your patience. The best thing you can do to help is continuously coming to a clinic whether having to wait there in a room that isn't your favorite. It is more efficient and things are going to a few weeks and things are going to be better in general. It is important that we understand that we are not going to be able to continue to continue to have a healthy and safe environment.
