1. Effective November, all general anaesthetics delivered private will now be covered for 2020-21 despite the following systems (e.g. chloramphenicol, fentanyl, propofol, remifentanyl, dexmedetomidine, and dexmedetomidine/propofol) remain outside the standard (1) consultation contract with major payments, reported to have the lowest cost.
