

- 1. New In-House Lab Tests Available Please see the <u>attached</u> memo from Allison Shaw regarding new lab tests being implemented in the next few weeks.
- 2. Rapid Test Changes Rapids are back Abbott has caught us back up on our back-order of Rapids. Beginning immediately, we will go back to the daily allotment of Rapids per site that we were previously working with. Providers have choice to order as they see fit, keeping in mind that regular send-outs are usually back in a day. Also keep in mind employees (but not family members) can test between 7 and 8:30 am, M-F, via the east entrance in Layton. Employees can also get send out testing done at the East Layton clinic during the day. We are ramping up 'negative' results, Rapid or send out, to auto-populate in Tanner Clinic patient portal every hour. Patient simply needs to complete portal registration before testing is resulted. This will help speed up test results for those with portal accounts. Provider can see if patient has registered for portal by looking at the blue patient information bar as shown below. If patient signs up for LabCorp portal, they will still get send out results through that portal as well. Positives will still be called by the staff to patients.

There are three places it is most easily accessible. The primary and most reliable is by clicking the 'Patient Portal' link on the patient information bar and looking at the 'Patient Registration Status'. If it says 'REGISTERED', the patient is enrolled.
