- 4. Updated Mask Policy effective Friday, May 21
  - **All Tanner Clinic Staff** are asked to please wear masks while entering our facilities via patient areas, while in patient accessible areas, and when directly involved in patient care – with the exception of while in the exam room when both the staff member and patient have been vaccinated and both feel comfortable with removing masks.
  - Tanner Clinic staff that have received their COVID vaccine are no longer required to wear masks in non-patient areas, including while in providers' offices.
  - Tanner Clinic staff that have not received the vaccine are asked to please continue wearing masks when within an unprotected 6 feet of other persons.
