- 1. Board Election Information and Reminders-** Board voting for three positions continues. Round one ends Thursday, June 10th. For each position where there is no clear majority, a second round of voting will start.
- 2. Fraudulent Calls to Dr's Offices** – One doc reported his patient received a phone call from "Tanner Clinic" (including real caller ID) asking for SSN in order to dig more into needed medical background. We will put out a statement reminder to patients to watch for this scam. Any doc office who hears the same, please forward as much information from your patient as possible so Administration can do as much investigating as possible.
- 3. Leadership Presentation** – Kellen is our new Pop Health director (replacing Joe). He gave the attached PowerPoint presentation today about the role of Pop Health in the clinic and its ever-present future. He focused on meeting Pop Health needs of lowering costs and increasing quality in order to share insurance savings with the doctors (in place of, and usually more than, the historical annual fee schedule increases). Kellen's focus will be to make the efforts very provider-focused, with efforts to reduce or eliminate paper forms and involve specialists in what THEY can do to assist the Pop Health work.
- 4. COVID Update** – Dr. Candice Smith – Candice reviewed a very informative PowerPoint (attached) on the actual statistics behind vaccinations as compared with the social media versions. Bottom-line, vaccinations are safe, much safer than actually getting COVID, and, if COVID still comes, dramatically reduce the impact of COVID. Please tell your patients to get vaccinated in an effort to continue the decline of COVID presence and effect. The PowerPoint is worth a read-through.
- 5. Documentation Time-Saving Tips in EMR** – Mike Kirkham – Dr. Mike was present today to begin a series of instruction on how to reduce time in documenting patient encounters and get home earlier (or be present when you ARE home). Time ran out today, so he just taught how to reconcile a COVID vaccine into our EMR from the state's databank.
