



Dear Parent,

Hello! I'd like to tell you about a research study that my team and I are running at our office.

GlaxoSmithKline (GSK) is sponsoring a research study to test the immune response and safety of a meningitis B vaccine. In the US, the GSK meningitis B vaccine is approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) for people ages 10 to 25 years.

Meningitis B is an infection that can cause serious harm to the brain, spinal cord, and blood. It's a rare disease but life-threatening and can lead to death or life long disability.

In the study, we will enroll infants aged 6 to 12 weeks and therefore the use of the meningitis B vaccine is investigational. Here's some important information about the study:

- > Your baby's time in the study will last 22 months
- > Over that time, there will be 7 in-office visits and 13 phone calls
- > There are 3 blood draws: at 7, 12, and 13 months of age
- > Participation is your personal decision and completely voluntary
- > You will be compensated \$100 for each completed in-office visit
