ROUTINE HEALTH EXAMS

Routine health exams are important to assure good growth, proper preventive care, immunizations, and development. During the newborn period it is recommended to be seen "2,2,2." Two days after discharge, two weeks of age, then two months of age. Then four, six, nine, 12, 15, 18 and 24 months of age. The six and 18 months check ups need to be scheduled at least six months after the first Hep B and Hep A respectively. The AAP recommendation is to then do annual check ups near the child's birthday.

3, 4 years	Well Check, Autism Screen, Vision	
5 years	Vision, MMRV, DTap, IPV	
6-10 years	Well Check, Vision Screen	
11-12 years	Tdap, MCV4, HPV, Depression Screen	
13-15 years	Well Check, Depression Screen	
16-18 years	Well Check, MCV4, Bexsero, Depression
