

CANTHARIDIN (CANTHACUR) INSTRUCTIONS

- Canthacur is a blistering solution which causes redness, swelling, and fluid accumulation under the lesion.
- 30 minutes after treatment the area(s) should be washed carefully with soap and water.
- DO NOT SCRUB the area(s). There should be a film over the treated area(s) after washing.
- If severe stinging or burning occurs before the 30 minutes are up, it is okay to wash the area sooner.

- DO NOT SCRUB the area(s) as there should be a film over the treated area(s).
- Blistering will start to form in about 3 to 8 hours post treatment for most people.
- Some people may be very sensitive to the Canthacur and may experience a tingling or burning sensation at the treatment site(s). Tylenol or Advil may be taken for discomfort.
- In 1 to 2 weeks crusting, scabbing, and peeling occur. Vaseline may be applied using a Q-tip to help the healing process.
- If the area(s) become very red, painful to the touch and/or looks infected, please contact the clinic at 801-773-4840 to speak to our staff.
